



Announcement by the Faculty of Science, Prince of Songkla University
The 2023 Scholarships for Foreign Graduate Students (2nd Round)

To support and promote graduate-level studies and research, increase the international atmosphere, and foster relationships among talented students from all over the world, the Faculty of Science, Prince of Songkla University (PSU) announces the 2023 scholarships for foreign graduates who have excellent academic performance. The details and conditions of the scholarships are addressed below.

1. Scholarship types and no. of scholarships

The scholarship is a tuition fee waiver. There will be no living expenses provided to the student.

1.1 Up to 3 grants for a student pursuing Doctoral degree (3 years or 6 semesters)

1.2 Up to 5 grants for a student pursuing Master's degree (2 years or 4 semesters)

2. Application Requirements

2.1 Eligibility is restricted to new graduate students who are expecting to begin their studies at the Faculty of Science, Prince of Songkla University in the academic year 2023

2.2 The applicant must hold a Bachelor's Degree for a Master's Degree scholarship, or a Master's Degree for a Doctoral Degree scholarship.

2.3 The applicant must pass an officially recognized English language exam as detailed in item 4.1 below.

3. Terms

3.1 The scholar must report the progress of their studies to the Faculty every 6 months.

3.2 To fulfill the scholarship requirements, the scholar must publish his/her dissertation in a reputable, peer-reviewed journal(s) indexed in ISI Web of Science: 2 publications for a Doctoral Degree, 1 for a Master's Degree. The publication must address "Faculty of Science, Prince of Songkla University, Hat Yai, Songkhla, Thailand" and the acknowledgment must refer to "This work was supported by the Faculty of Science Research Fund, Prince of Songkla University".

3.3 The scholar must maintain good academic standing ($GPA \geq 3.25$) and complete their studies within the given time frame.

3.4 Once an applicant has been accepted for a particular program of study, the scholar is expected to complete that program and cannot change to a different program of study.

3.5 The scholar needs to apply for a Non-immigrant "ED" visa (Study Permit). Scholars entering Thailand on a tourist visa cannot enroll and may have their scholarship canceled.

3.6 Other terms apply as established by the Faculty.

4. Required Documents

4.1 A copy of an English proficiency certificate (valid within 2 years) with a minimum score as follows:

- TOEFL Paper Based score of 500, or
Computer Based score of 173, or
Internet Based score of 61, or
Institutional Testing Program score of 520, or
- IELTS Score of 5.0

4.2 Curriculum Vitae (CV).

4.3 Transcript of the highest degree obtained, as well as a transcript of the Bachelor's degree.

4.4 Research description/plan in English (about 800 words).

4.5 A medical certificate (in English).

4.6 A copy of the main passport page.

Remark: The Faculty reserves the right to reject an application if the required documents are incomplete.
